Indulgence Reimagined

The design, created by a former Wüst architect, is modern and inviting – so successful that many customers opt to sit down for a coffee instead of simply making a purchase. teamtischer was responsible for project planning, including scheduling and budgeting, as well as detailed execution design and construction. A former 250 m² car dealership was transformed to include a retail area, a comfortable seating area, and a kitchen.

Over the course of the project, teamtischer faced several challenges. The start of construction was delayed by three months due to objections, numerous requirements from the municipal water authority had to be met, and the tricky installation of a monoblock unit in the limited space above the refrigeration/freezer room had to be mastered. "It's simply beautiful!" say customers as they relax with a coffee, enjoy a snack, or indulge in a small sweet treat.

The Peak to Be

The «TITLIS Project» is one of the most ambitious construction initiatives in the Swiss Alps. The Titlis infrastructure is being upgraded for the future – both architecturally and ecologically. The renovation of the base station souvenir shop into «The Valley Shop» is a first step toward this broader concept. Its goal is to modernize the shopping experience – moving away from the classic souvenir kiosk toward a lifestyle atmosphere, while also expanding the offering to include snacks.

The shop concept was designed by teamtischer designer Kurt Zeltner. A highlight is the use of decommissioned gondolas, which serve as seating areas or photo hotspots. teamtischer successfully completed the project despite a very tight schedule – concept development in spring, planning in summer, construction starting in September, and opening in October. After all, we also aim for “The Peak to Be” (the official slogan of the TITLIS cable cars).

In 2016, Sephora became well known among Swiss "beauty addicts" with its entry into the Swiss market in Geneva. Since then, numerous additional locations have opened, including shop-in-shop concepts in stores such as Manor and in shopping centers. However, the plan was always to operate independent, standalone stores. In February, the time had come: the premiere at Geneva's Rue de la Croix-d'Or was celebrated. Calling it just a «shop» would be an understatement – across a spacious 320 m² of retail space,

complemented by 120 m² of back-office area, Sephora presents its products generously in a high-quality, minimalist, and stylish environment. teamtischer managed the project as general contractor across all trades.

The highlight: construction was completed on the originally planned date despite a two-week construction halt ordered by heritage protection authorities. As it turned out, the supposedly historically significant wall was simply an "old" wall.
